## ONECOTE CEMETERY

Onecote Cemetery is owned and maintained by Onecote Parish Council. To assist in the administration and maintenance of the Cemetery and the graves therein, the Parish Council has issued the following advice for the bereaved.

- 1) All fees to be paid in full before a headstone is erected.
- 2) No headstone will be erected on a grave unless a Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial has been purchased.
- 3) To assist in Cemetery maintenance all graves must be kept in a condition level with the surrounding ground.
- 4) No kerbstones will be allowed around the grave.
- 5) Headstones must not be wider than the plot - usually 2ft wide.
- 6) Headstones should not be more than 2ft 6ins high.
- 7) The base stone of headstones may incorporate flower urns.
- 8) The number of the grave should be discreetly engraved on the reverse of the headstone.
- 9) The approval of Onecote Parish Council is required, in writing, before a headstone is installed.  

To this end a drawing, or plans drawn to scale, with dimensions, of the proposed headstone and a copy of the proposed inscription and an illustration of any device thereon, must be submitted to the Parish Council.
- 10) No trees or shrubs to be planted on graves at all. Plants permitted are bulbs and flowers providing that they do not encroach beyond the gravespace.
